Essential Data

Manchester has developed a Supported Internship Data Tool which was implemented in September 2023. We will be asking colleges to complete and return this to us annually.

The Data Tool is a 'self-assessment' and acts as a census as well as capturing information on internship outcomes.

The first Tool asked for historic data from 2021/22 onwards, so that we could understand the growth of internships over the period.









Essential Data

Outcomes that we track include:

- Number of Interns
- Number of Pre-Interns
- How many secured paid work (16+ hours)
- How many secured paid work (-16 hours)
- How many participated in voluntary work?
- How many went on to Further Education?
- How many were NEET following the internship?



We also ask colleges to draw a distinction between interns that have an open EHCP to MCC, and those from outside of Manchester.


