Our research training is available in easy-read and plain language and includes the following topics:



- An introduction to research



- Staying safe and being **ethical** (which means being an honest and fair researcher)



- Introduction to collecting **quantitative data** (which means the amount of something, so that data can be counted or added up)
- ...and collecting **qualitative data** (which means collecting information, for example, from interviews, stories or meetings)



- What to do with the qualitative and quantitative data you collect



- How to share what you've found.

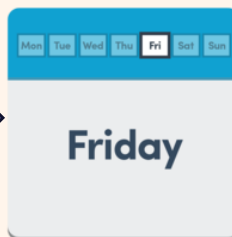
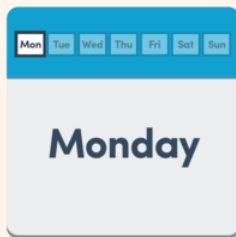

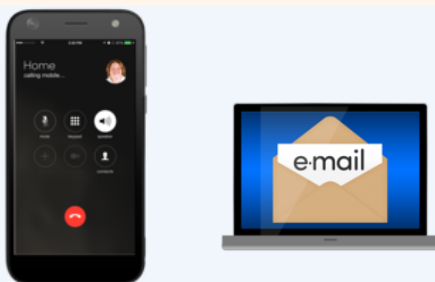
